Community Conversations ensure that citizens have the opportunity to share priorities for the agenda of the upcoming UPG 2019 in Lagos. From June 2019 onwards, Hosts provide spaces where citizens review the 5 Executive Priorities for Lagos and share their responses to questions that include:

- 1. How does this Priority affect my life and the lives of those around me?
- 2. What part of this Priority is the most important?3. What issues are currently missing and should be considered?
- 4. What kind of solutions are possible to some of the issues highlighted?
- 5. What kinds of commitments must be considered?
- 6. What can each of us do to be part of the solution?

The comments, ideas, and recommendations influence the design of the programme in October. Participants in official Community Conversations may select 3 people whose contributions stood out during the session. These people are included in a short list of citizens for consideration to be invited to additional activities.
